Parent plants

Rode Boskoop Schmitz-Hübsch red mutant.

Origin

Discovered by J. van Laar in Margraten, the Netherlands.

Growth

Even growth when compared to Red Boskoop Schmitz-Hübsch.

Flowering

Early, triploid, self-intolerant.

Recommended pollinators are: Cox, Delcorf, Idared, James Grieve, Pinova, Evereste and Professor Sprenger.

Productivity

Early and good. Slight tendency to biennial bearing.

Harvesting

From the fourth week of September up to mid October.

Appearance

Firm on all sides and intense red, not streaked. Typical Boskoop appearance.

Quality

Fruit flesh firm, sour in taste. Excellent eating apple. Also suitable for cooking.

One (1) harvest. Favourable size selection, mainly 75/85 mm.

Storage life

Well-suited for early sales, but also for long storage.

Earliest colouring stable Boskoop mutant.
