Parent plants

Braeburn mutant.

Origin

J. and S. Hill, Hastings in New Zealand.

Growth

Medium strong, no bare wood and rather flat branch arrangement.



Flowering

Mid-season, simultaneous with Elstar and Jonagold.

Recommended pollinators are: Delcorf, Idared, Pinova, Malus Golden Hornet and Malus Professor Sprenger.

Productivity

Good, early and ultimately regular.

Harvesting

Beginning of October, ± 7 days before the standard Braeburn. Has a smaller harvest period than the standard Braeburn.

Appearance

Reasonably large fruit, slightly larger than the standard Braeburn. Clear light red blush.

Quality

Firm and crispy fruit flesh. Excellent in taste and juicy. Very high sugar content.

Storage life

Up to April as a minimum, with a very long and good shelf life.
