

# Braeburn Mariri Red

## Parent plants

Braeburn mutant, discovered in Mariri in the Nelson-Golden Bay in New Zealand.

## Origin

Davodeau-Ligionnaire, Angers, France.

## Growth

Medium strong, fairly open tree.

## Flowering

Mid-season, Simultaneous with Elstar and Jonagold.  
Recommended pollinators are: Delcorf, Idared, Pinova, Malus Golden Hornet and Malus Professor Sprenger.

## Productivity

Good, early and regular.

## Harvesting

Beginning of October,  $\pm$  5 days earlier than the standard Braeburn.

## Appearance

Red-purple streaked with a red colour (90%, also at the shadow side) on a green-yellow background.

## Quality

Firm and crispy fruit flesh. Excellent sweet-sour taste and juicy. Very high sugar content.

## Storage life

Up to April as a minimum, with a very long and good shelf life.
