

Decosta Jonagold de Coster[®]

Parent plants

Jonagold colour mutant.

Origin

Discovered by G. Swillen, Belgium, 1984.

Growth

Vigorous young trees, moderate when older.
Favourable horizontal branch arrangement.



Flowering

Mid-season. Triploid. Somewhat self-tolerant, however cross-pollination recommended. Recommended pollinators are: Braeburn, Cox, Delcorf, Elstar, Gala, Golden Delicious, Idared, Junami, Pinova, Wellant, Malus Golden Gem, Malus Golden Hornet and Malus Professor Sprenger.

Productivity

Excellent, early and regular. Requires little pruning, slight tendency to biennial bearing.

Harvesting

As of the end of September, up to the end of October.

Appearance

Very large fruits. Fairly dark red colour (when moderate coloured – slightly streaked).

Quality

Fairly firm to firm apple with yellow-white, juicy fruit flesh. Taste is good to excellent.

Storage life

If cooled, up to the beginning of January; until the end of July in ULO-storage.
Good shelf life.
