Moderately strong, upright.

Flowering
Mid-season, 4 days before Cox, simultaneous with Idared.

Productivity
Good.

Harvesting
End of September.

Appearance
Medium-sized, square to flat conic, at times spheroid and round. Green-yellow to golden yellow, with a golden orange-brown blush. The skin is almost fully coarse.

Quality
Solid, creamy white fruit flesh with a yellow-green tone and a fine structure. This is dry and becomes dryer when the fruit is stored longer. Sweet with a nut flavour.

Storage life
October-December.
