## Parent Plants

 + (Idared x Maigold) x  Elstar.

## Origin

Agroscope Changins-Wädenswil ACW in Wädenswil, Switzerland.

## Growth

Moderate to weak. Easy branching, easily develops horizontally into hanging (fruitful) wood. Similar to Elstar, susceptible to scab and mildew. If standard spray scheme is used, only slight tendency to develop fruit tree cancer. Moderately affected by rosy apple aphid.

## Flowering

One to three days sooner than Elstar and Golden Delicious. Pruning need is more required than for Elstar. Recommended pollinators are: Braeburn, Elstar, Gala, Golden Delicious, Pinova, Rubens, Wellant and ornamental apple trees.

## Productivity

Good to excellent.

## Harvesting

End of September, beginning of October; broad harvesting period.

## Appearance

Smooth, unblemished, fresh and happy. Beautiful clear red up to somewhat dark red. Green yellow and relatively pale base colour. On average: 75% blush.

## Quality

Juiciness is excellent, texture is crispy and fine, fresh taste and fruity aroma.

## Storage life

Eight months in ULO-storage and, as does Elstar, requires storage to obtain a perfect taste development.

## Details
